This is a great time of the year. The Sale Rams are shorn and look well. Our stud lambs are growing strongly and our commercial stock are gaining weight. The sheep meat industry is buoyant, with strong lamb, mutton and wool prices. Solid forward contract prices

through until late in the year have given many clients the chance to lock in excellent guaranteed returns.

It is exciting to see the next stage of our studs development with the introduction of new sires in both breeds.

Our 2015 A.I. program went well, with Kurralea Eleven-11 (\$28,000) again leaving plenty of quality. Ulandi Park 125-12 was also used, and has several outstanding progeny.

In 2014 we purchased Kentish Downs 291-13 for \$7,000. We are always on the lookout for rams to further lift our quality and 291 has certainly done this. He was naturally joined to about 60 maiden ewes, mostly Eleven-11 daughters, averaged 150% lambing and has left some impressive lambs.

We expect some very high Lambplan figures from this joining and more importantly, they are structurally sound and clean pointed.

Thanks to the hard work of Dustin Cross, all 2015 stud lambs have been tagged at birth. With more accurate pedigrees we expect to see a dramatic lift in our studs ASBV's in the future.

2014 HIGHLIGHTS

The 2014 Ram Sale saw another outstanding result. 164 Poll Dorset and White Suffolk rams were sold in a total clearance, averaging \$950, up \$197 on the previous year.

Thank you to Kathy Simons, Pembroke Stud, who purchased the \$4,300 top priced stud ram.

Other stud buyers included Michael King, Netley Park, Bordertown at \$2,800, and Darryl and Sherin Hobbs at \$2,000.

In the 10 years of our Auction Sales, we have sold over 1,500 rams to more than 50 producers, a fact we are very proud of.

2015 SALE

This year's Sale Rams were scanned as ram lambs and will be scanned again before Sale Day. Most ram lambs averaged 75-100 kg in February with good muscling and shape at the right age.

We will offer approximately 175 Poll Dorset and White Suffolk rams this year, our largest offering to date. This is our best draft of White Suffolk's yet with approximately 25 to be offered on October 7.

Rams will be graded visually and will present very well with most weighing between 100-120 kgs on Sale Day.

Several Poll Dorset rams are of stud quality, sired by Kurralea Eleven-11 (A.I. \$28,000), Newbold 65-12 (A.I. \$9,000) and other proven Ulandi Park sires and Kurralea sires.

Rams from Janmac are eligible to enter South Australia and all other Regional Bio Security Areas. Rams are Gudair vaccinated and fully Brucellosis Accredited Free (Flock 2102). We are proud of our stock and guarantee their health status.

All rams have been back-lined with "Avenge" at shearing, fully vaccinated and drenched with "Duo Care" on August 10, 2015. Of course our rams are fully guaranteed for their first working season. If you have any issues, please feel free to speak to us personally.
